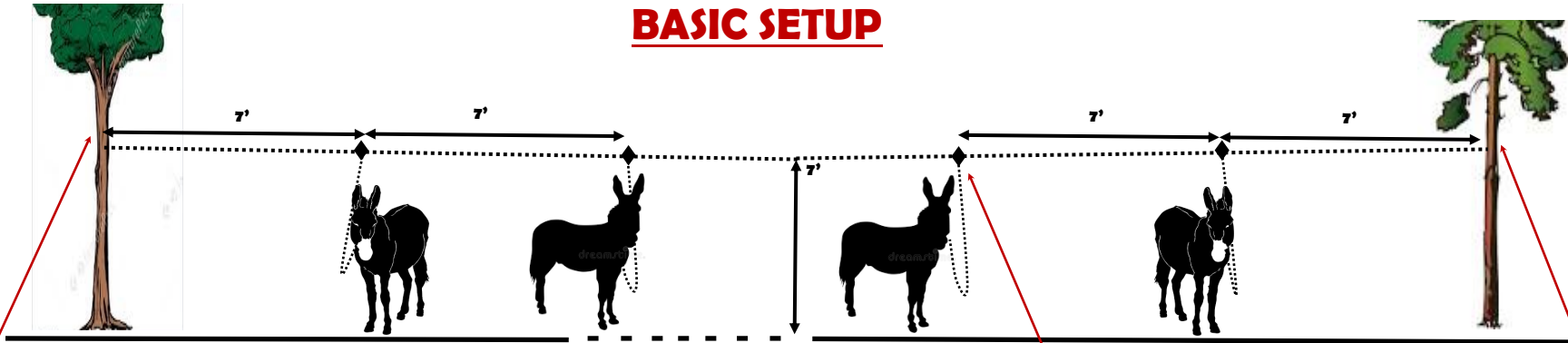


HOW TO SET UP A HIGHLINE

BASIC SETUP



RULE OF SEVENS: 7 FEET FROM ANCHOR TREES; 7 FEET HIGH; 7 FEET BETWEEN ANIMALS

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

#1 ROPE Fifty (50) to one hundred (100) feet of low-stretch rope between 3/8" and 1/2" in diameter.

#2 "TREE SAVERS" One at each end of the highline rope.



#3 SWIVELS To prevent animals from tangling their lead ropes. (Optional.)



#4 "TRUCKER'S HITCH"
To tighten the highline.
